CAR PARKING

SEATING

Seating is **NOT** provided. You will need to bring your own camping chairs or picnic blanket. Remember to check the weather forecast on the day of the Concert and come prepared for the conditions. If you intent to sit with friends and family during the Concert please try and arrive around the same time. On arrival you may select to sit in one of the zones below dependant on what you bring with you:-

ZONE A - Chairs and blankets only.

ZONES B & C - Day tents or beach tents, no bigger than 1m in height are permitted IN ZONE B & C

ZONE C - Gazebos are permitted.

Areas CANNOT be reserved for friends and family – Please arrive together.

Umbrellas – If you intend to bring large/golf umbrellas please be mindful of the visitors around you. Our team may ask you to move location or put umbrellas down if they are obstructing the view of others.

TICKETS

Tickets sales online will end three days before the concert date. Tickets will be available on the door subject to availability. The price of these will be Adults £22, Children £17. Please bring your tickets on your phone and have them ready to show at the entry point. Make sure to arrive with everyone you have purchased tickets for and anyone you intend to sit with throughout the Concert.

The Gift & Coffee Shop is closed from 15 August to 6 September. During this time tickets can only be purchased online.
